

Tabernacle means “dwelling place”
God’s dwelling place is in heaven, but God
tabernacles with his people




5 different names

- 1) Tabernacle (Exo. 25:9)
- 2) Sanctuary (Exo. 25:8)
- 3) Tent (Exo. 26: 36)
- 4) The tabernacle of the congregation (Exo. 29:42)
- 5) The tabernacle of testimony (Exo. 38:21)



Purpose of the Tabernacle (Exo. 29: 43-46)


- 1) God used the tabernacle to meet with the Israelites
- 2) It symbolized the presence and protection of God

(John 1:14)

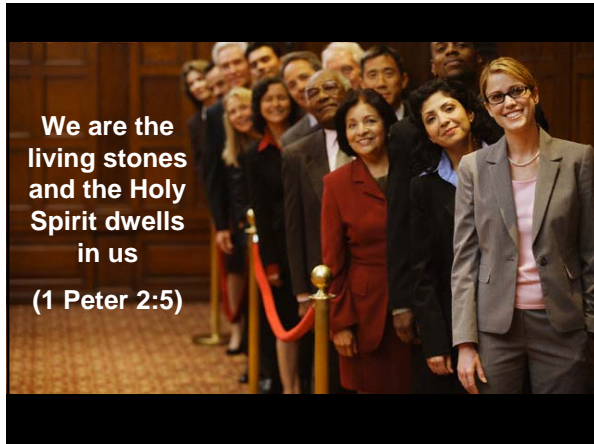
God tabernacled
