




# The Day of the Lord

(1 Thess. 5:1-11)

## “Time and date”

This refers to events foretold by God that are yet to pass (v.1)

**Day of the Lord (v. 2)**

- An OT concept
- In the NT, it is a period of time beginning with rapture and ending with the coming of new heaven and earth



**Day of the Lord**

- time of God’s wrath on the unsaved world
- Also called as “day of redemption”, “day of God”, “day of Christ”, “last day”, and “great day”

**Three Analogies:**  
 The coming of the “Day of the Lord” will be like:

- a thief in the night (v.2)
- a sudden destruction (v.3)
- labor pains of a pregnant women (v.3)




**The Day of the Lord will not affect faithful believers (v.4)**



**Believers  
are all sons  
of the light  
and sons of  
the day (v.5)**

**Be alert and self controlled to  
escape from the day of the  
Lord (v.6)**



**Preparation  
needed for Day  
of the Lord**

- put on faith and love as a breastplate (v.8)
- put on the hope of salvation as a helmet (v.8)



**Encourage one another and build each other with hope of escaping from the Day of the Lord (v.11)**
