- from Caesarea





Godly Cornelius:

The vision that God gave Cornelius:

- To satisfy Cornelius's spiritual hunger
- Through the vision, God told him to call for Peter
- Cornelius obeyed God's command



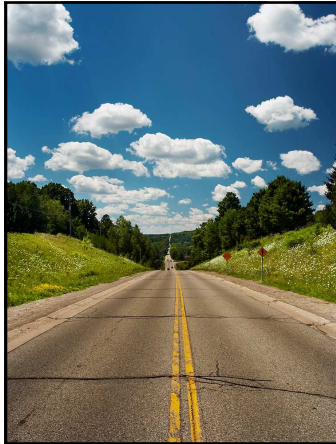
The vision that God gave Peter:

- To prepare Peter for his encounter with Cornelius
- The message of the vision was that salvation is not only for the Jews, but also for Gentiles

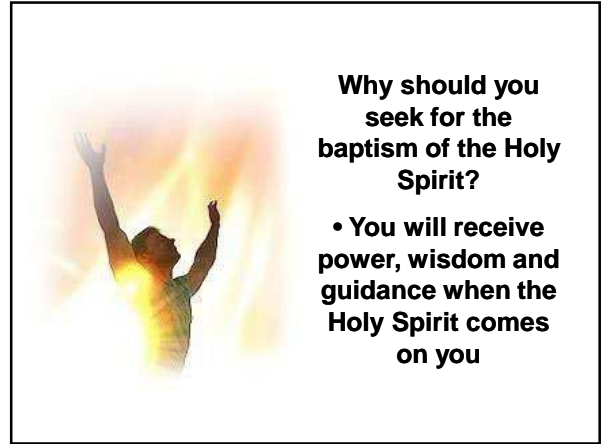


Joel 2:28:

Joel's prophecy**

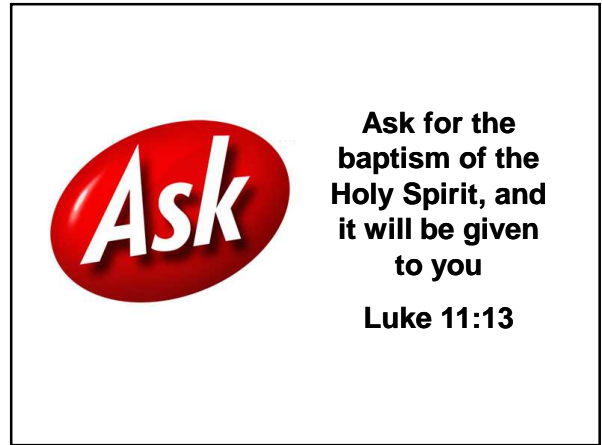


**Why should you
