



The Believer's Dress Code
Col. 3:12



Colossians:

- One of the prison epistles of apostle Paul
- It is believed that Epaphras was the one who first brought the good news of salvation to Colosse (1:7)
- This epistle was written around 62 A. D.

Purpose of the epistle:


- To stop the "hollow and deceptive philosophy" (2:8)
- To clear confusion (2:16)
- To warn against an unholy lifestyle (3:5)




Rules for holy living:

- Set your hearts on things above (3:1)
- Set your minds on things above (3:2)

Cont'd:




- Put to death sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and greed (3:5)
- Get rid of anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language (3:8)
- Stop lying to each other



A believer's dress code:
Clothe yourself with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience (3:12)

A believer's dress code:

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another (3:13)



A believer's dress code:

Put on love over compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience (3:14)




A believer's dress code:
