The Lord is Holy (Lev. 19:2):

- There is no moral blemish, no defect, no stain of wickedness in God
- God hates all forms of sin and evil




We must be holy (Lev. 19:2):

- We are called to lead a life of purity and obedience
- We must separate ourselves for God's service


What did Christ say about holiness?

- Our righteousness should surpass that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law (Matt. 5:20)
- Be perfect like our God the father (Matt. 5:48)




What did Paul say about holiness (2 Cor. 6:14-17):

- Do not be yoked together with unbelievers
- We are the temple of the living God
- Be separate from unbelievers




What did Peter say about holiness?

- Be holy in all you do (1 Peter 13-16)
- Abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul (1 Peter 2:9-12)



Paul advises us to:

- put to death the misdeeds of your body (Rom. 8:12-14)
- put to death the acts of sinful nature in you (Gal. 5:19-21)



Paul advises us to:

- Set our hearts on things above
- Set our minds on things above
- Put to death all that belongs to our earthly nature (Col. 3:1-5)
