


The Wages of Sin

Rom. 6:23


Sin:

- Willful breaking of religion or moral law
- Is transgression (Ps. 51:1)
- Is lawlessness (1 John 3:4)



Transgression can occur in thought, word, or in deed:

- Thought: hatred (1 John 3:15)
- Word: fool (Matt. 5:22)
- Deed: murder (Rom. 1:29-31)




Sin:


- All wrongdoing is sin (1 John 5:17)
- If you break one commandment, it is just like breaking all of them (James 2:10)




If you know what is good and you do not do it, you are sinning (James 4:17)

Unbelief in God is sin (Heb. 3:12)






How did sin originate?
Sin originated with Satan (Isa. 14:12-14)



How did sin enter the world?
Sin entered into the world through Adam's disobedience (Rom. 5:12)




What is the result of sin?
The wages of sin is death (Rom. 6:23)




Uncover your sins:

- Confess and forsake your sins (Prov. 28:13)
- Ask for forgiveness of your sins (1 John 1:9)



False repentance:
"I have sinned"
(Exo. 9:27, Num. 22:34, 1 Sam 15:24, Joshua 7:20, Matt. 27:4)



Process of Sin (James 1:14-15):

- Man is tempted by his own evil desire and enticed
- After evil desire has conceived, it gives way to sin
- Sin, when full-grown, gives birth to death
